

3 Card Poker

How to play:

An exciting Stud Poker game that offers three ways to play and four ways to win: Players may bet against the dealer, bet on the value of their own three-card hand or both. The Dealer qualifies with Queen High or better. If the Dealer does not qualify, you push on the play and get even money on the Ante.

Play Pair Plus

Bet the pair plus spot to bet on your own hand. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win! It's just you and the cards.

Pair Plus Pays:	Pair	1 to 1
	Flush	3 to 1
	Straight	6 to 1
	Three of a Kind	30 to 1
	Straight Flush	40 to 1

Play Ante

Bet on the Ante spot to play against the dealer's hand. If you bet on the spot and like your hand, you must place a wager on the Play spot that is equal to the Ante. It's your 3 Card Poker hand against the Dealer's 3 Card Poker hand, best hand wins!

Play Both

It's you and the cards for a pair or better; it's you and the Dealer for the best 3 Card Poker hand. You must also make the Play wager or you will forfeit the Ante and Pair Plus wagers.

Ante Bonus

If you make the Ante and Play wagers you may win a bonus payout even if the Dealer doesn't qualify, and even if the Dealer's hand beats your hand.

Ante Bonus Pays:	Straight	1 to 1
	Three of a Kind	4 to 1
	Straight Flush	5 to 1

Dealers are happy to explain the placement of any bets, but the players are responsible for the correct position of their wagers on the layout, regardless of whether they or the dealer have placed the bets.
