

Caribbean Stud

How to play:

Caribbean Stud Poker is essentially a simplified five card stud poker game. Players put up an ante and are dealt five cards. Once the Player looks at his hand, the Player may choose to play by doubling the ante or fold, in which case the ante is lost. The Dealer then exposes his card.

If the Dealer does not have Ace/King or higher, the Player wins even money for the ante. If the Dealer has at least Ace/King and his hand is higher than the Player's, he collects the ante and the bet. If the Player's hand beats the dealer's, the Player wins even money on the ante and odds on the bet, as follows:

Payout Odds

Pair or less	1 to 1
2 Pairs	2 to 1
3 of a Kind	3 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Flush	5 to 1
Full House	7 to 1
4 of a Kind	20 to 1 (max \$1,000)
Straight Flush	50 to 1 (max \$1,000)
Royal Flush	100 to 1 (max \$1,000)

Progressive Jackpot

Players may play for the Progressive Jackpot after placing their ante bet by putting another chip in the slot in front of their bet. Regardless of whether the Player wins or loses the hand, the Player will receive the following bonuses:

Royal Flush	Jackpot - 100% of the Jackpot
Straight Flush	10 % of the Jackpot
4 of a Kind	\$500
Full House	\$100
Flush	\$50

(Maximum payoff on the bet is \$1,000)
