



Craps

How to play:

Craps is a fast-paced, exciting, and after you've spent a little time playing, surprisingly easy game! Craps is played with only two dice. Only one player at the table has run of the game at one time. The shooter selects two of the five dice offered and returns the others to the stickman. The shooter must make a "Pass Line" or "Don't Pass Line" bet prior to rolling the dice.

The come-out roll is the most important roll in the game of Craps, since it determines the point that must be repeated before a "7" is rolled.

Bets on the Come Out Roll

(first roll of dice)

Pass Line

Automatic Winners: 7 & 11

Automatic Losers: 2, 3 & 12

Any other number becomes the "point". You win if the shooter rolls his point again before rolling a "7" and lose if he rolls a "7" first.

Don't Pass Line

Opposite of Pass Line

Automatic Winners: 2 & 3

Automatic Losers: 7 & 11

Stand Off: 12

Any other number becomes the "point". You win if the shooter rolls a "7" before the point.

Dealers are happy to explain the placement of any bets, but the players are responsible for the correct position of their wagers on the layout, regardless of whether they or the dealer have placed the bets.

Bets on rolls after the point has been established

Come Line

Treats the next roll exactly like a Pass Line on the Come Out roll. (Minicraps tables do not have Come Lines)

Field Bets

This is a one-roll bet that you can make at any time. If 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 or 12 is rolled, you win. If any other number is rolled, you lose.

Don't Come

Treats the next roll exactly like a Don't Pass Line bet on the Come Out roll.

Place Bets

You can place a bet on an individual number and increase, decrease or remove it at any time. You win if the number you select is rolled before a 7 is thrown. These bets are never in effect on the Come Out roll. Place Bets are passed to the dealer who puts them in the proper location.

Hard Way Bets

You can bet that the shooter will roll a 4, 6, 8 or 10 the "Hard Way". That is, with a pair of 2's, 3's, 4's or 5's. If a 7 is rolled or if the number bet is rolled but not the "Hard Way" the bet loses.
